FIRE SAFETY ACTIVITIES

PARKING LOT SAFETY

Please hold your child's hand when entering or exiting the building and use walk-ways next to the building. We have a busy parking lot, especially at preschool drop-off and pick-up times. Also, please remember that children should **never** be left in cars unattended. Our administrative staff is happy to assist in bringing your child to the classroom if you must leave a sibling in the car due to illness, etc.

CHICKADEE NEWS

The Chickadee classroom has been a hubbub of activity during September. For many children this is a first experience in a preschool setting, so there is much excitement, stimulation and even a little hesitation. Our focus during this time has been "getting acquainted" with our school community. This has involved getting to know classmates and families in our room, the teachers, routines and rules of school, plus the outdoor environment. Along with getting acquainted comes the territory of increasing independence. We have been promoting bathroom skills, using words to make needs known, learning to share and separating from parents for extended periods.

A DAY IN THE CHICKADEE CLASS

Our "circle times", while short in length, work on long term skills. Conversation and listening skills are practiced along with "following directions". We work on these areas through music and song, movement, storytelling and group discussion. The Chickadees love to listen to stories and songs. Some of their favorites are "Pete the Cat", "Sticky Bubblegum" & "The Bear Hunt."

In art we have colored and painted with different tools on varying mediums. We have introduced Dabber Dots and that their job is to hop, hop, hop. All these activities strengthen fine motor skills and stimulate creativity.

Our lunchtime experience has a strong emphasis on sitting appropriately along with polite social behavior and conversation at the lunch table, while we have a terrific time learning about one another. Name cards will be introduced at snack and lunch times to initiate name recognition this month.
