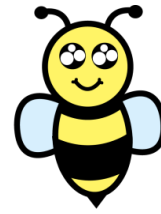


# CAMP LOTTA-FUN

### MORNING WELCOME

Camp Lotta-Fun will begin at 8:45 AM each morning. At 9:00 AM all classes will meet in the gym for our camp song, pledge to the flag, birthday recognition, announcements, and morning music/movement. Then the children will resume their regular classroom schedule.

### THINGS TO BRING

- ❖ Towel and water shoes for sprinkler fun (PLEASE LABEL EVERYTHING)
- ❖ Change of clothes to be kept in child's cubby
- ❖ Sleeping bag and pillow for rest time if staying for the afternoon – make sure to bring a special "snuggly" – (i.e.) blankie or soft sleep toy- we can send it home each night!

NOTE: Swimsuits, water shoes, towels and sleeping bags need to go home weekly for laundering.



### SUNSCREEN AND INSECT REPELLANT

Please apply sunscreen and insect repellent on your child before bringing him/her to school. Wee Know staff will re-apply as needed during the day, provided you have checked the "yes" boxes on the Health History Form that gives us permission to use these products on your child.

### SIGN IN/OUT CLIPBOARD

Please be sure to sign IN and OUT on our classroom clipboard each day. For your child's safety and everyone's peace of mind please be sure to speak to a teacher upon arrival and departure.

### \*\*\*NOTE ABOUT FOOT APPAREL\*\*\*

Please send your child to school in sturdy tennis shoes or sandals with a strap around the ankle and covered toes. We discovered Crocs or flip-flops are slippery when wet and don't always stay on or support a child's foot when he/she is running. Water shoes can be purchased at area stores. If you choose to bring water shoes, please bring a separate pair of shoes to change into for inside use. Thank you for supporting your child's safety. Please remember to label everything.

### SWIMSUITS

Please bring your child to school with their swim suits already on (under clothes for girls) and sunscreen applied. It saves our campers so much "waiting time" to get outside and play. We will always change your child into dry clothes before lunch.



### LUNCHES

Children should bring their lunch in an insulated lunch bag with a freezer pack and be placed in the red bin in the hall marked "BUMBLEBEES". Wee Know does provide milk and water so it is not necessary to send a drink. Please LABEL clearly your child's name on the outside for easy reference.

### SNACKS

Please check the attached calendar to see if your family has been assigned to bring a morning snack this month for our Bumblebee class. Due to NAC (National Accreditation Guidelines) homemade snacks are no longer allowed. Prepared food being shared among children must be commercially prepared. Please try to send a healthy snack for 12 children on your assigned day (extras are helpful in case they get dropped). If your child has specific food allergies, please feel free to send a snack from home and we will be happy to serve it to your child at snack time. Thank You!
