April was a fun month with themes including weather, spring, caring for the environment, animals, and mothers and flowers. For our weather theme, we graphed each day as a "lion" or "lamb" day and talked about winter vs. spring weather. (We were so happy when the "lamb" days finally arrived after a long winter!) We even made our classroom look more like spring with all our artwork! For our spring theme, we planted a class garden and our own popcorn plants. We graphed the number of days that it took for our plants to grow. Along with our spring theme it was also the "Week of the Young Child". The children loved working together to make a painting for the gym on Masterpiece Monday, eating fruit pizza on Tasty Tuesday, getting extra time to play in the gym and outside on Wednesday, seeing and learning about animals on Thursday, and pajama day on Friday! During our caring for the environment theme, the children learned how to make paper out of recycled paper and created art all week using recycled materials. They learned the importance of recycling, saving energy, saving water, and protecting nature. With our animal theme, the children had fun learning about the different kinds of animals around the world and in Wisconsin.
